The 2007 vintage was a moderate crop over all; Riesling was short, however.

The wine is lovely and dry, with bright fruit aromas of Riesling, wonderfully balanced. We like this wine very much.

Beginning with our 1983 Riesling vintage we boldly went where no other American winery would go for the next 17 years – we changed our label from Johannisberg Riesling to the true and correct name – Riesling. While White Riesling is legally correct, it is none the less both wrong and redundant – when was the last time you had a red Riesling? This is just one example of our commitment to this wonderful and no longer overlooked varietal.
